The Extra Data Field Section of the *World Trade Atlas* ® *is the official source of State export data* utilizing the Harmonized Tariff Schedule (HTS). It was developed in cooperation with the U.S. Bureau of Census and contains up-to-date State data by origin of movement into the export market. The Harmonized Tariff Schedule is based on the international Harmonized System, the global classification system that is used to describe most world trade in goods.

U.S. Department of Commerce Facts:

- Ninety-five percent (95%) of the world's consumers live outside of the United States, representing eighty percent (80%) of the world's purchasing power and 92% of its economic growth.
- Exports of goods and services grew at an annualized rate of 1.96 percent over the last 4 years (2013-2016).
- Exports directly and indirectly supported 10.7 million U.S. jobs (2016) and 41,168 Arkansas jobs (2016).
- ➤ International trade accounts for more than a quarter of U.S. GDP.
- > Jobs supported by exports were 10.7 milion in 2016, up 1.2 million since 2009. In 2016, every billion dollars of U.S. exports supported 5,744 jobs.
- ➤ Total employment supporting U.S. agricultural exports increased from 1,067,000 in 2015 to 1,097,000 in 2016. The agricultural export surplus helped to offset some of the nonagricultural trade deficit.
- Fifty-nine percent (59%) of small & medium-sized businesses that export sell in only one market, with Canada being the most prominent. In Arkansas, seventy-eight percent (78%) of exporters are small & medium sized businesses.

Executive Summary

Arkansas ranked 38th in the U.S. in value of total exports in 2017 (\$6.3 billion). The state's trade increased 10.82 percent from 2016-2017. In the last five years, the overall volume of exports from Arkansas have increased. Total exports from Arkansas in 2017 were 21.2 percent above total exports in 2010.

Canada continues to be Arkansas's largest trading partner accounting for \$1.3 billion in exports in 2017, or 19.85 percent of total exports. Canada is the top destination for six of the state's top ten commodities: machinery (\$197 million), plastics (\$96 million), paper/paperboard (\$85.3 million), electrical machinery (\$76 million), vehicles, other than railway (\$61.5 million) and cereals (\$59.2 million).

Mexico is Arkansas's second largest partner, with more than \$846 million in goods exported from Arkansas last year. Arkansas exports to Mexico include: dairy produce (\$127 million), iron and steel (\$89 million), electrical machinery (\$77 million), vehicles, other than railway (\$71 million), meat (\$70 million), cereals (\$63 million), paper/paperboard (\$53 million), machinery (\$51 million), aircraft/spacecraft (\$32 million) and fish/crustaceans (\$27 million).

In 2017, aircraft/spacecraft was Arkansas' largest export. Exports in this sector accounted for 23.77 percent of Arkansas's total export value in 2017 (\$1.5 billion). The top three destinations for aircraft/spacecraft from Arkansas were France (\$693 million), Switzerland (\$153 million) and United Kingdom (\$117 million).

Mexico and Central America were the largest foreign markets for Arkansas poultry in 2017, accounting for 43.95 percent of shipments. Total Meat and Edible Offal exports increased by 17.13 percent in 2017 and accounted for 4.56% of the overall Arkansas commodities. Mexico was the top country in which poultry was exported (\$70.4 million) with a 26.73 percent increase from 2016. Other countries to note are Hong Kong (\$64 million) with a percent increase of 24.70 and Taiwan (\$16.6 million) with a percent increase from 2016 to 2017 of 590.10.

Cereals exports increased overall by 12.81 percent (\$360 million) from 2016 to 2017. Haiti was the top market for Arkansas rice in 2017 (\$119 million), followed by Mexico, Canada, Colombia and Saudi Arabia. Foreign shipments of Arkansas paper and paperboard increased by 31.95 percent in 2017. Exports in the sector to Canada increased substantially (25.93 percent), and realized significant increases in purchases from the Australia (4065.08 percent), Thailand (841.07 percent), Costa Rica (415.15 percent) and Italy (231.46 percent).


Trade in machinery is the second largest export which experienced a moderate 3.55 percent overall increase from 2016. Major purchases were from Canada (\$197 million) and Mexico (\$51 million).
