Arkansas Export Statistics 2019

The Extra Data Field Section of the *World Trade Atlas*® is the official source of State export data utilizing the Harmonized Tariff Schedule (HTS). It was developed in cooperation with the U.S. Bureau of Census and contains up-to-date State data by origin of movement into the export market. The Harmonized Tariff Schedule is based on the international Harmonized System, the global classification system that is used to describe most world trade in goods.

U.S. Department of Commerce Facts:

- Nearly ninety-six percent (96%) of the world's consumers live outside of the United States, representing two-thirds (66%) of the world's purchasing power and 92% of its economic growth.
- Exports of goods and services grew at an annualized rate of 3.02 percent (2018).
- Exports directly and indirectly supported 10.7 million U.S. jobs (2016 latest available) and 350,000 Arkansas jobs (2018).
- International trade accounts for more than a quarter of U.S. GDP.
- Jobs supported by exports were 10.7 million in 2016, up 1.2 million since 2009. In 2016, every billion dollars of U.S. exports supported 5,744 jobs. (Latest available)
- Total employment supporting U.S. agricultural exports increased from 1,097,000 in 2016 to 1,200,000 in 2017.
- Agricultural exports generated an economic output of \$317 billion in the 2017 United States economy. (Latest available)
- Fifty-nine percent (59%) of small & medium-sized businesses that export sell in only one market, with Canada being the most prominent. In Arkansas, eighty percent (80%) of exporters are small businesses.

Executive Summary

Arkansas ranked 38th in the U.S. in value of total exports in 2019 (\$6.2 billion). The state's trade decreased 3.43 percent from 2018-2019. Total exports from Arkansas in 2019 were 19.3 percent above total exports in 2010.

Canada continues to be Arkansas's largest trading partner accounting for \$1.5 billion in exports in 2019, or 24.65 percent of total exports. Canada is the top destination for five of the state's top ten commodities: railway or tramway rolling stock (\$377 million), machinery (\$215 million), plastics (\$102 million), electrical machinery (\$87 million) and paper/paperboard (\$62 million).

Mexico is Arkansas's second largest partner, with more than \$744 million in goods exported from Arkansas last year. Arkansas exports to Mexico include: dairy produce (\$127 million), vehicles, other than railway (\$77 million), iron and steel (\$71 million), electrical machinery (\$58 million), pulp of wood (\$53 million), machinery (\$44 million), paper/paperboard (\$33 million), edible prep of meat (\$28 million) and furniture (\$22 million).

In 2019, aircraft/spacecraft was Arkansas' largest export. Exports in this sector accounted for 19.94 percent of Arkansas's total export value (\$1.2 billion). The top three destinations for aircraft/spacecraft from Arkansas were France (\$679 million), Japan (\$200 million), and Norway (\$59 million).

Mexico and Central America were the largest foreign markets for Arkansas poultry in 2019, accounting for 55.54 percent of shipments. Total Meat and Edible Offal exports decreased by 5.76 percent in 2019 and accounted for 12.01% of the overall Arkansas commodities. Mexico was the top country in which poultry was exported (\$89 million) with a 14.50 percent increase from 2018. Guatemala was second with \$50 million. Other countries to note are United Arab Emirates (\$4.0 million) with a percent increase of 223.75 and Chile (\$1.4 million) with a percent increase from 2018 to 2019 of 898.58.

Cereals exports decreased overall by 24.55 percent from 2018 to 2019 with \$285 million in value. Haiti was the top market for Arkansas rice in 2019 (\$100 million), followed by Canada, Taiwan, Libya, Saudi Arabia and Mexico. Foreign shipments of Arkansas railway or tramway rolling stock increased by 1,749.48 percent in 2019. Exports in the sector were sought mainly by Canada (\$377 million), Mexico (\$4 million) and Brazil (\$498,000).

Trade in machinery is the second largest export which experienced a moderate 8.30 percent overall decrease from 2018. Major purchases were from Canada (\$215 million) and Mexico (\$44 million).

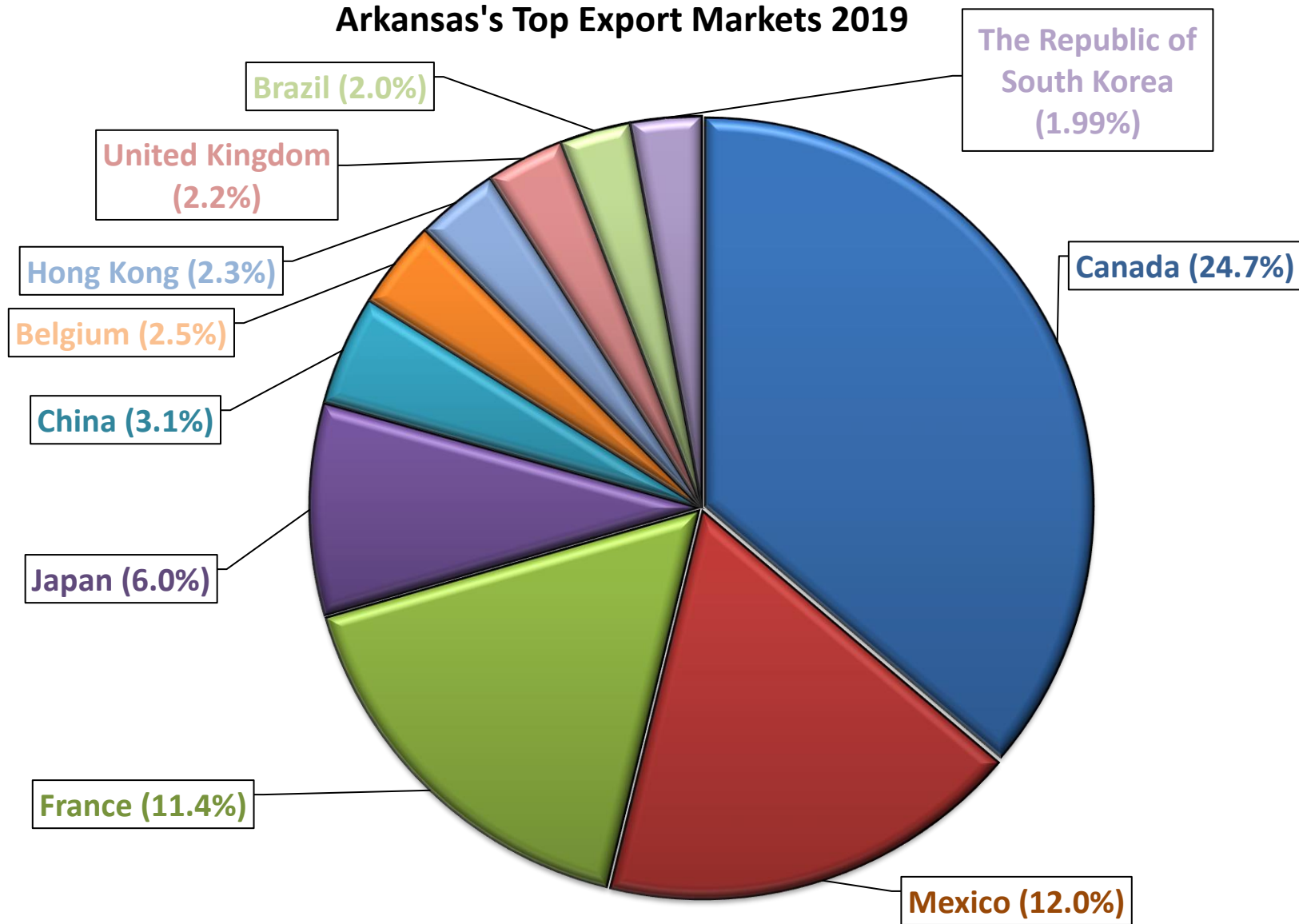

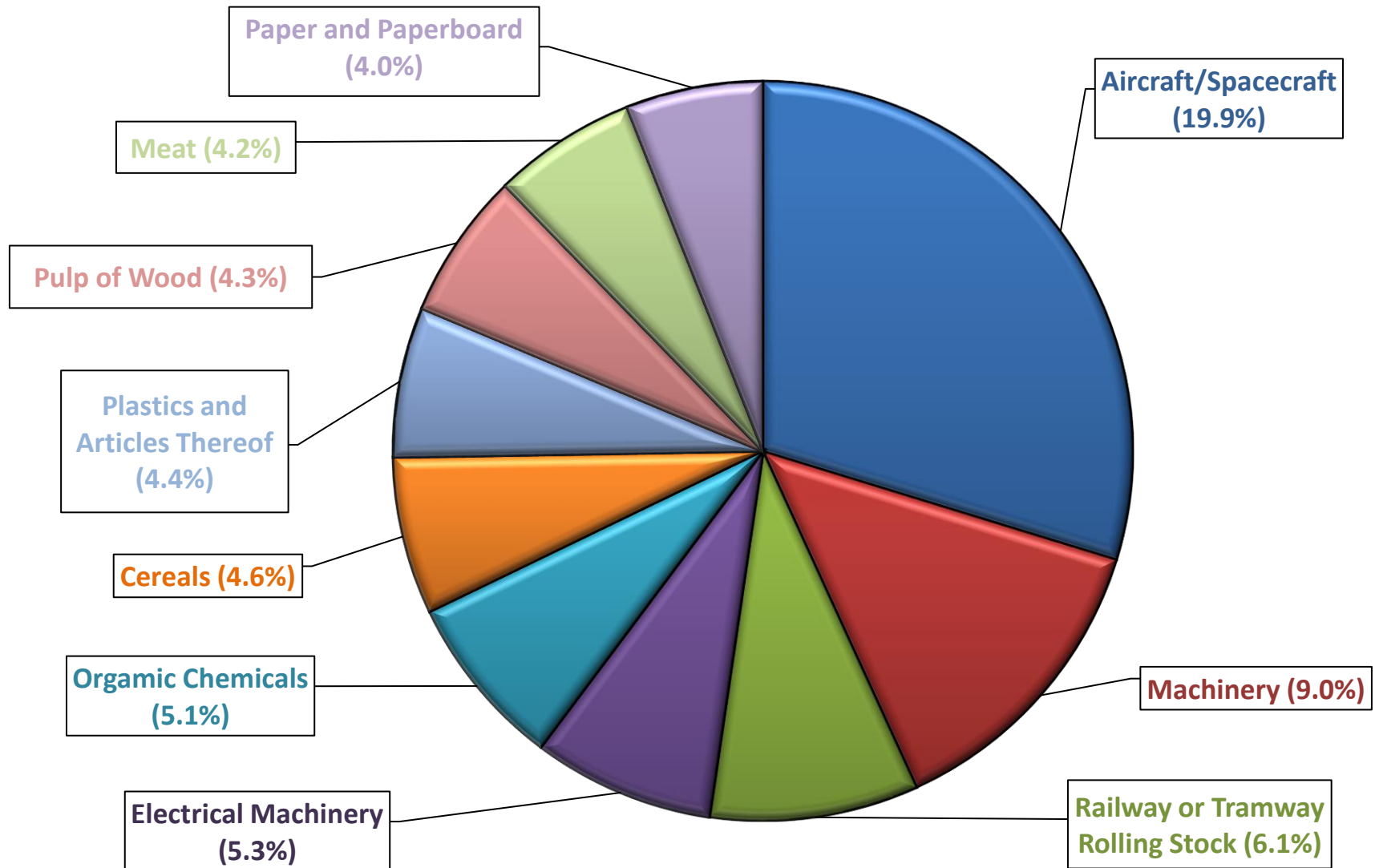

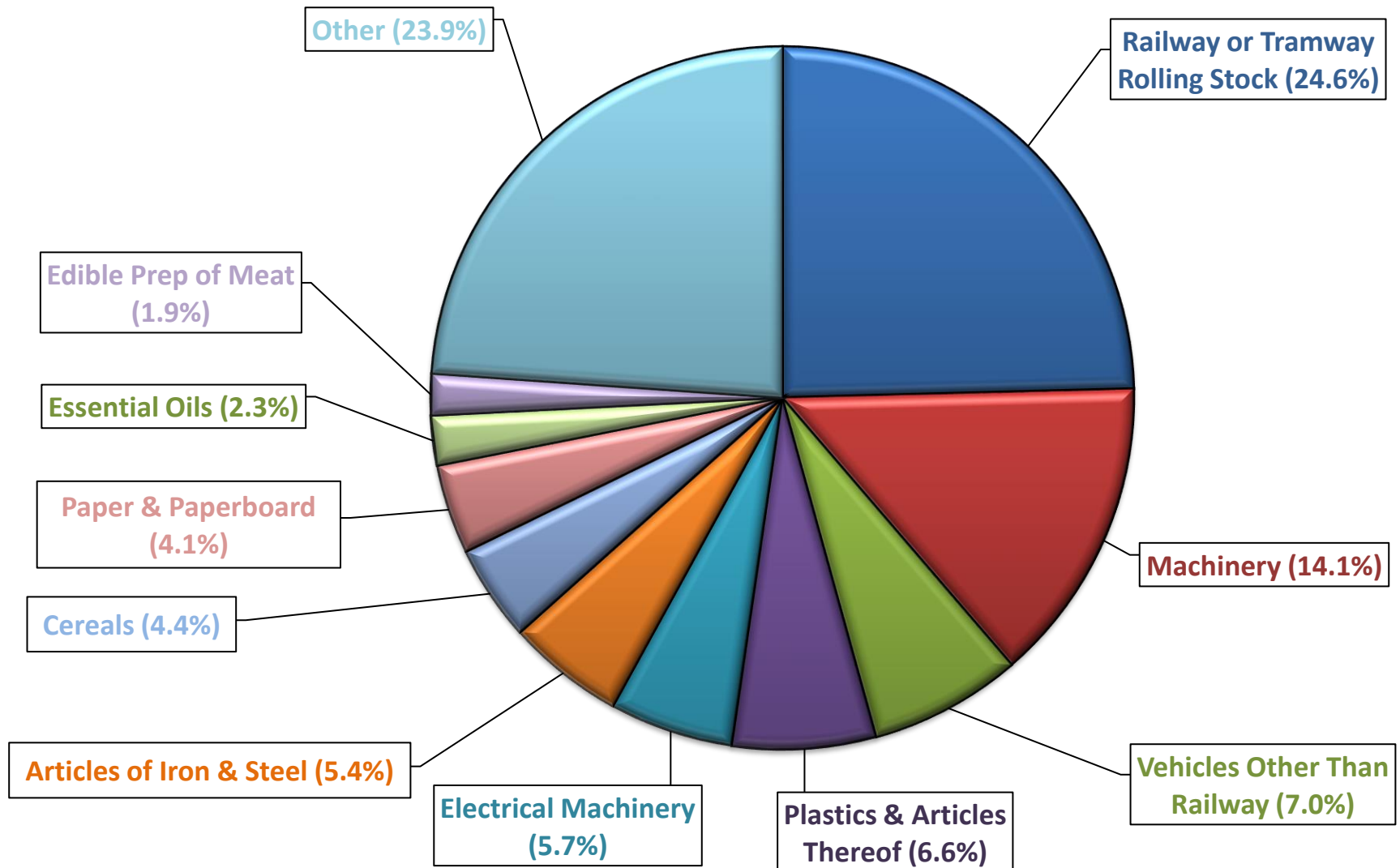

Arkansas Exports to Canada 2019



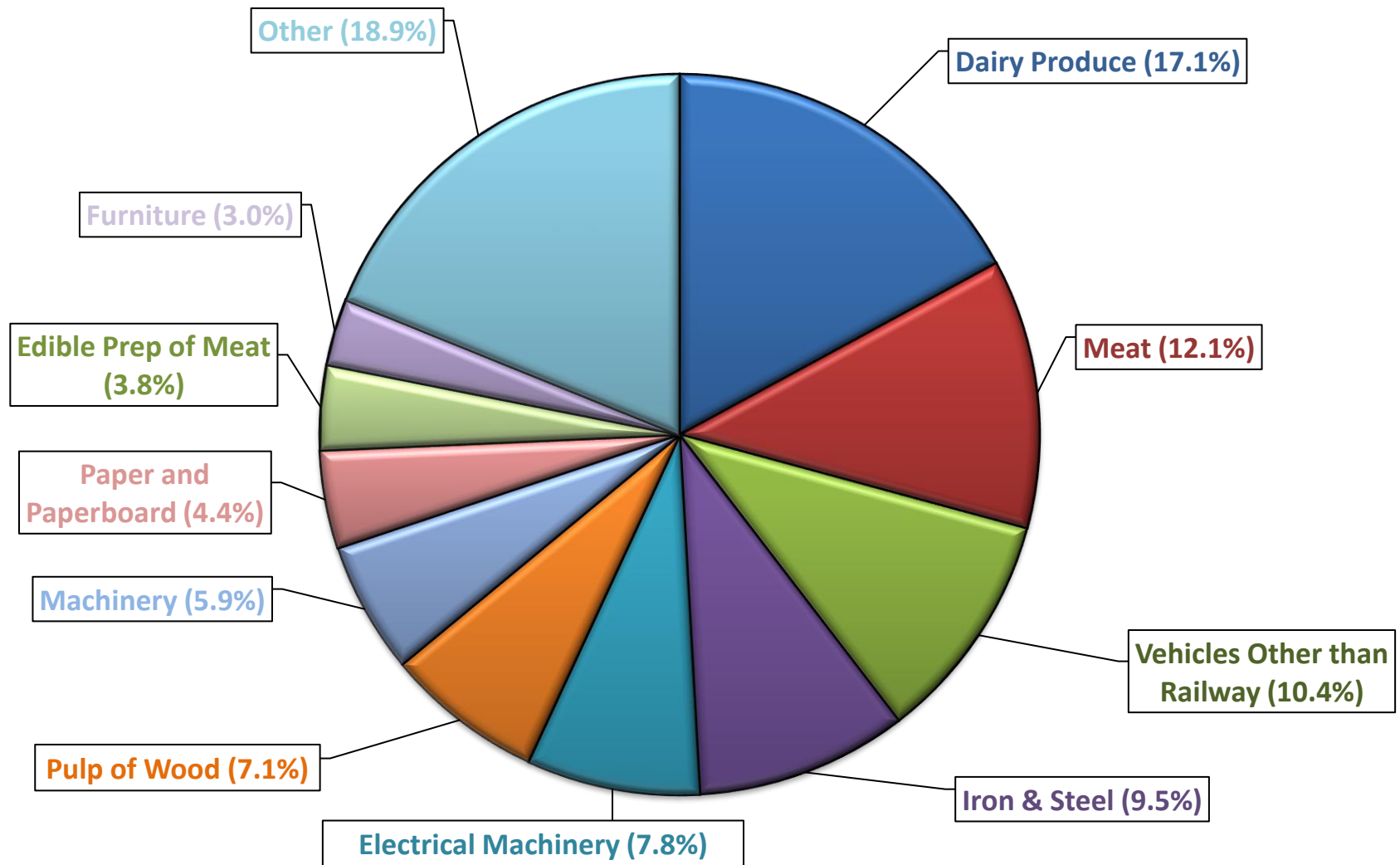

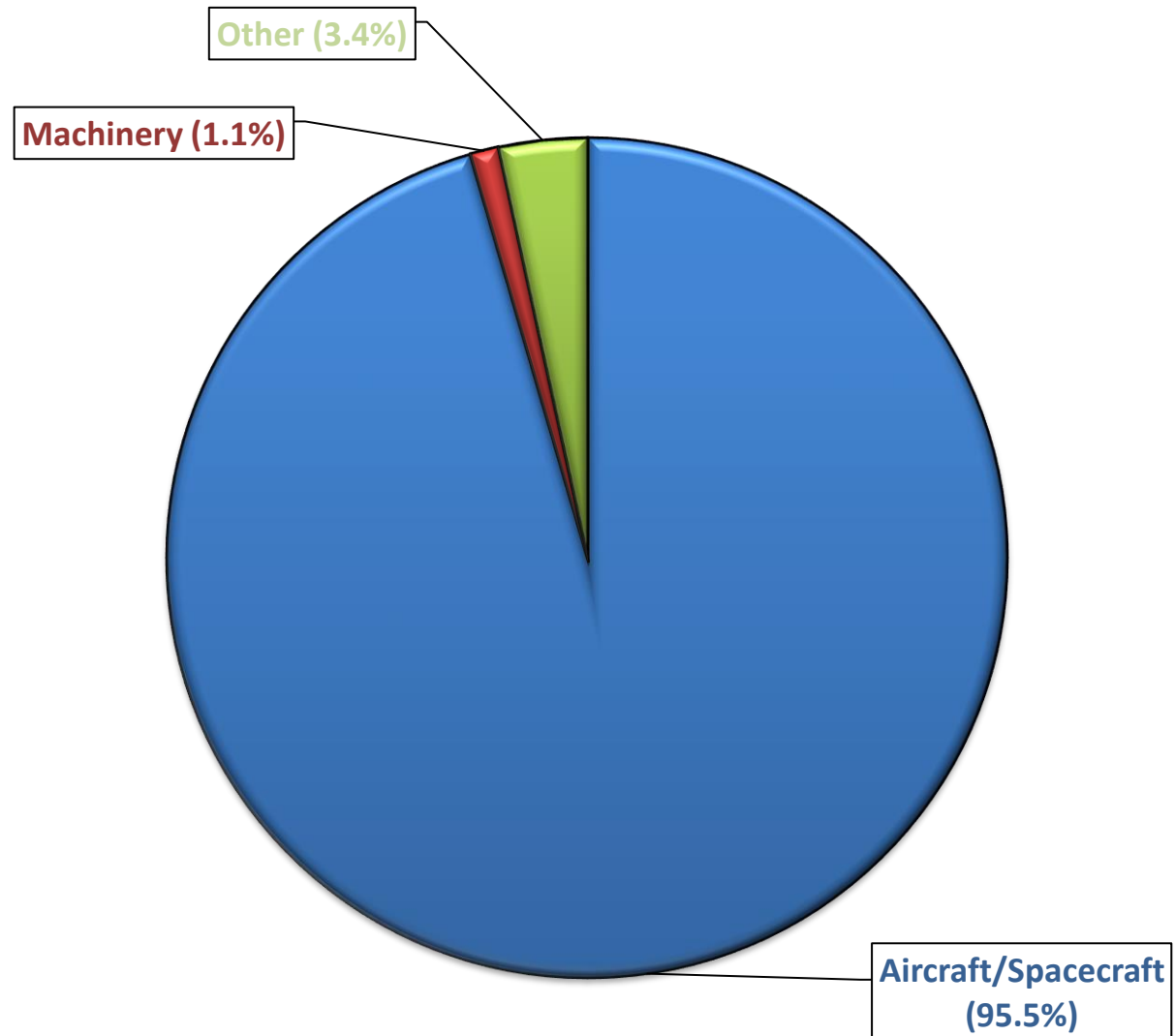

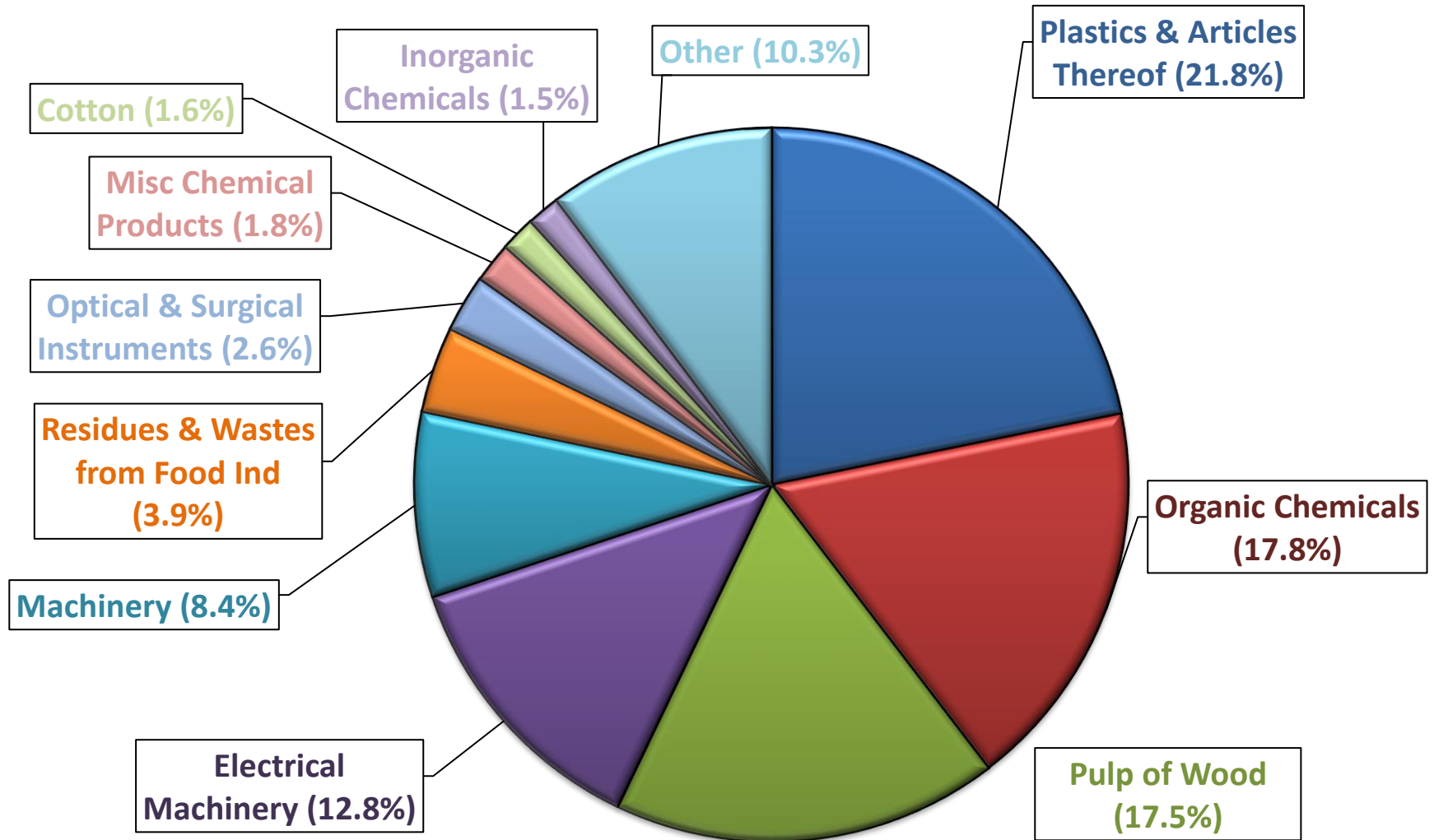

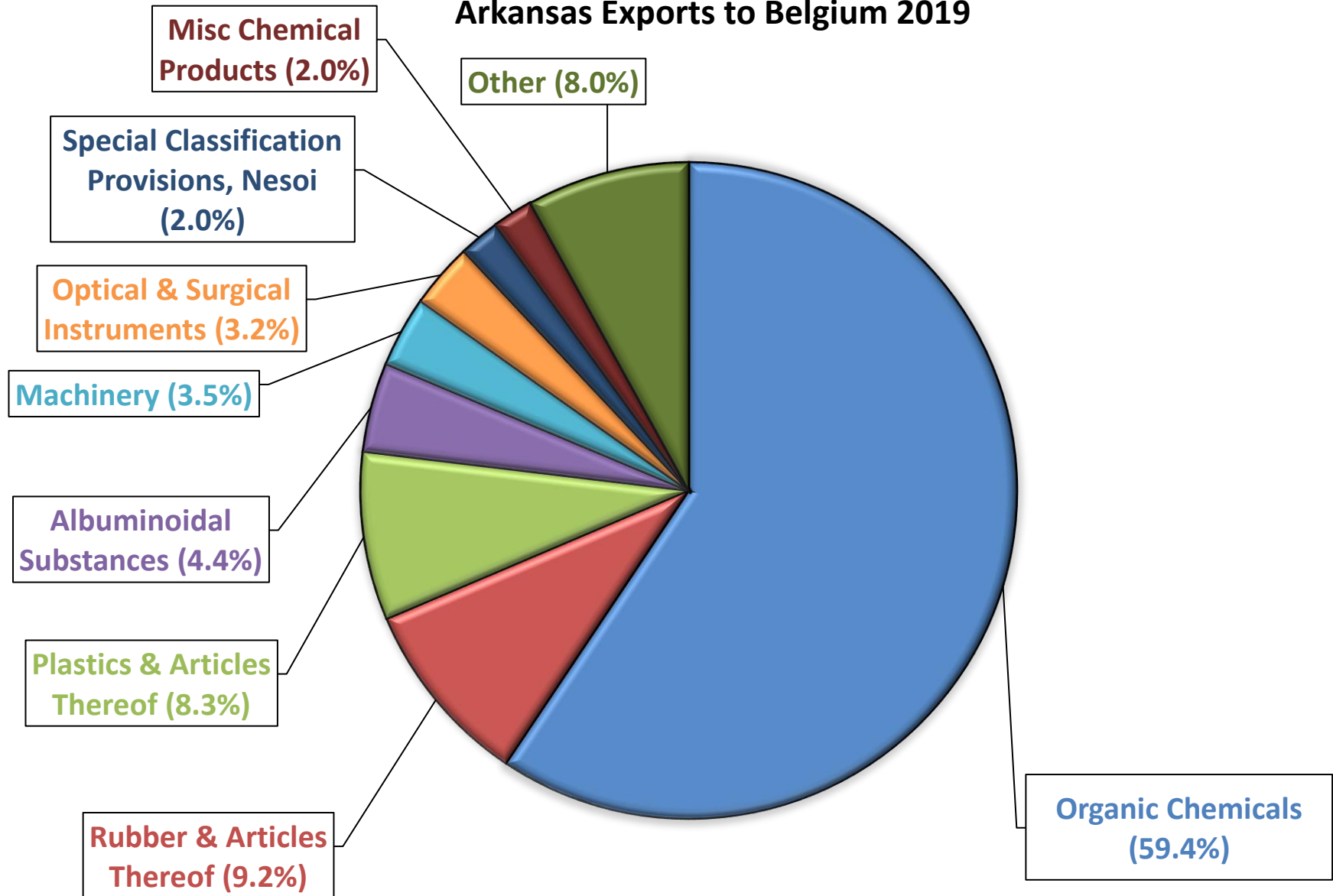

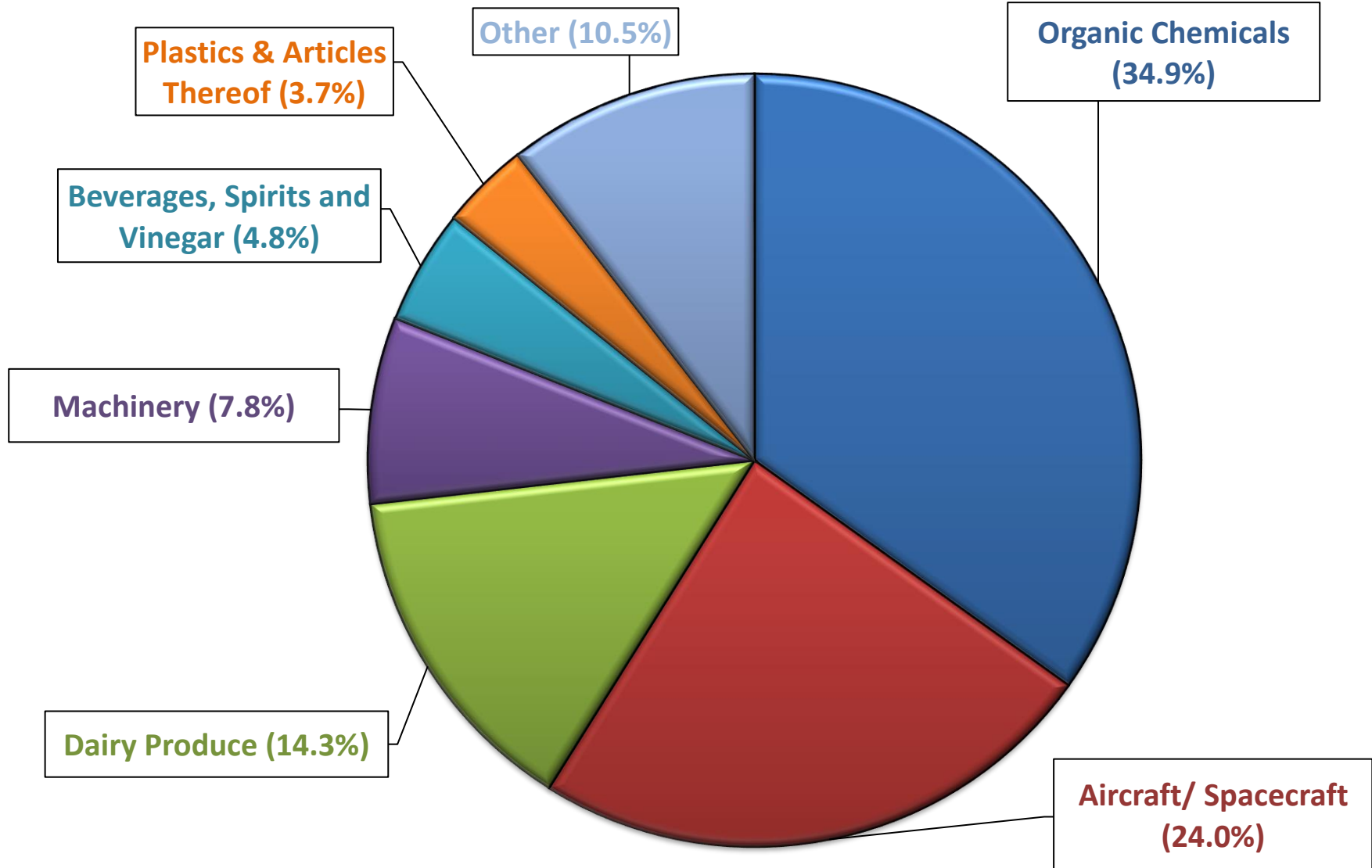
Arkansas Exports to United Kingdom 2019

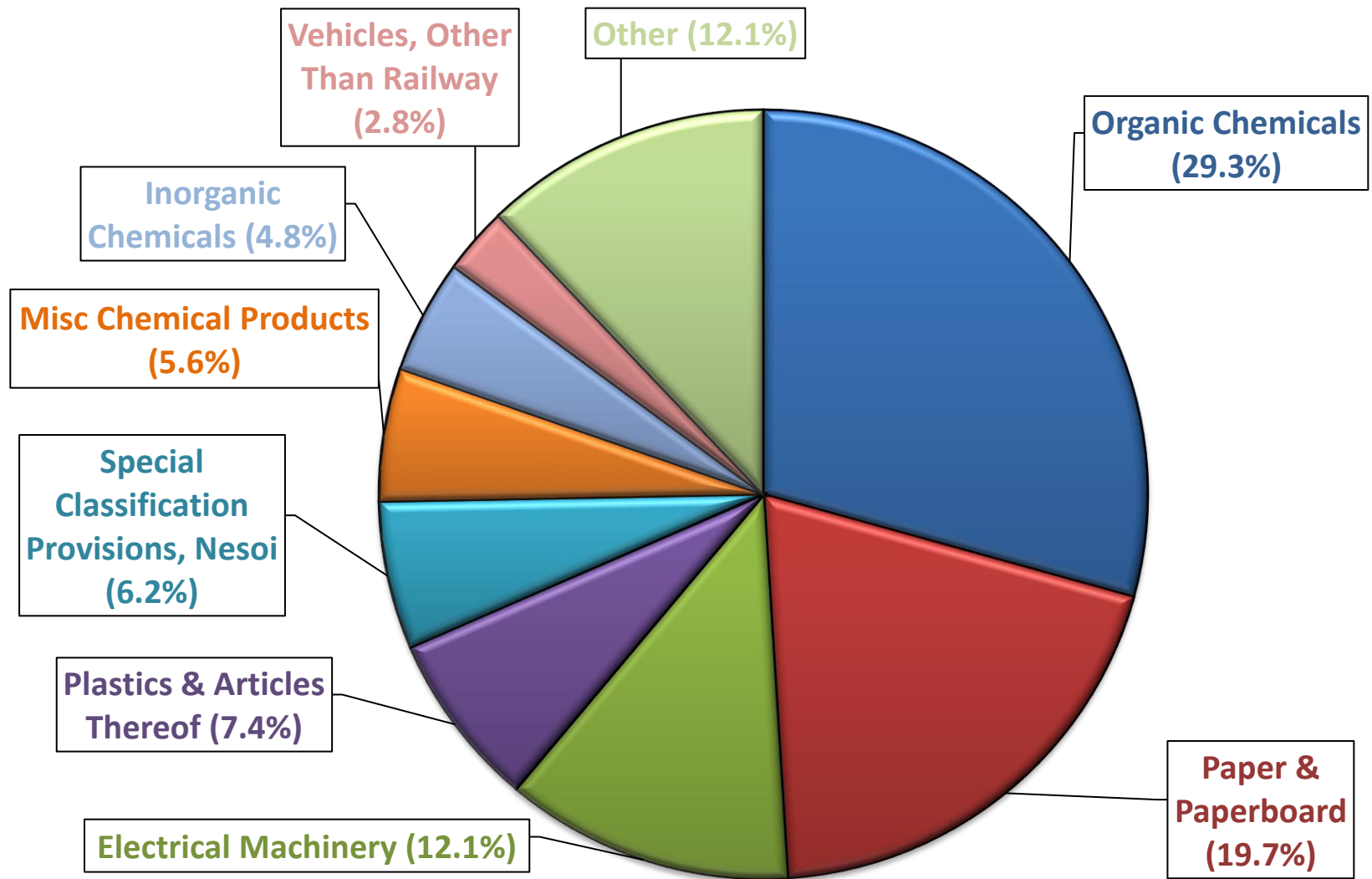
